Permit Instructions

1. Pick up permit application at township office or online.
2. Gather required information and install slow moving vehicle sign and rear view mirror.

Conditions of Permit

1. The applicant must have one of the following:
 - a) Valid Minnesota Driver's License or
 - b) Certificate signed by a physician that the applicant is able to safely operate a motorized golf cart.
2. Golf carts may only be operated on township designated roadways (see below).
3. Golf carts may only be operated on the designated roadways from sunrise to sunset unless they are equipped with original equipment headlights, taillights, and rear facing brake lights as contained in Minn. Stat. §169.045 Subd. 3. They shall not be operated in inclement weather or when visibility is impaired by weather, smoke, fog, or other conditions, or at any time when there is insufficient light to clearly see persons and vehicles on the roadway at a distance of 500 feet.
4. Golf carts must display the slow-moving emblem as described in Minn. Stat., Section 169.522 when operated on designated roadways.
5. Golf carts must be equipped with a rear-view mirror.
6. A copy of this permit must be carried in the vehicle at all times.
7. The permit decal and tag must be displayed at all times on the rear area of the vehicle, easily accessible/readable by law enforcement.
8. This permit expires on December 31st, 3 years after date of issue.
9. Valid liability insurance must be maintained by the applicant at all times.
10. Every person operating a golf cart under permit on designated roadways has all the rights and duties applicable to any driver of any other vehicle, except when those provisions cannot be reasonably applied to golf carts.

Designated Roadways

(Per Ordinance No. 126, for travel to and from Geneva Golf Course)

1. All township rural residential roadways (30 mph roads).
2. Geneva Golf Club Drive NE between Liberty Road and the Geneva Golf Course.
