Each of the agencies or organizations listed below provides low-interest loans and/or grants for the upgrading or installation of septic systems in Alexandria Township. Eligibility requirements for each loan program are different, but will generally require proof of family income, home ownership, and a credit check. ALEXANDRIA TOWNSHIP SEPTIC SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- Permits are required for the installation or repair of all septic systems in Alexandria Township. A design for the installation/repair must be submitted from a state licensed sewer designer. Permits are valid for 12 months from the date of purchase.
